A Churchill Fellowship offers Australians a lifechanging opportunity to travel overseas for four to eight weeks to learn more about a topic or issue that they are passionate about. As an internationally recognised award, recipients gain access to expertise from around the world.

Applicants are empowered to design their own projects to explore international best practice and innovation that can be applied in Australia.

There is a high level of visibility and credibility associated with being a Churchill Fellow and a responsibility to share the knowledge and skills gained overseas with the Australian community.

It is a competitive process, with more than 100 Churchill Fellowships awarded around Australia every year.

Eligibility

There are no prescribed qualifications, academic or otherwise, required to apply for a Churchill Fellowship. To be eligible to apply for a Churchill Fellowship you must:

- be an Australian Citizen or permanent resident over the age of 18
- not be enrolled in tertiary studies directly related to the topic of your proposed project
- have experience in and commitment to the field of your project
- have a project that requires overseas exploration
- be available to travel for 4 to 8 weeks
- be willing to share Fellowship findings with the broader Australian community.
